The Department has carefully reviewed the complaint you filed against First Magnus Financial Corporation. Simultaneously, we are in receipt of the Decision rendered by The Honorable Judge John Taylor who presides in the Mohave County Justice Court. The matter described in your complaint against First Magnus Financial Corporation, is a matter that must be settled through civil litigation and, as such, the Department cannot intervene until a court of reasonable has ruled in your favor.

This Department, as a State administrative agency, is not empowered to decide disputed questions of fact or law, or to interpret contracts. Such matters, if not resolved by the parties themselves, must be resolved in a local court of appropriate jurisdiction.

We are not in a position to determine whether your complaint has legal merit. Therefore, this complaint will remain on file in a closed status until we receive a decision by the Court that warrants reopening of this complaint.
