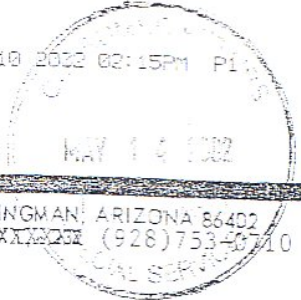

ORDER TO CONTINUE


In response to Defendant's Motion to Continue this matter on the Court's calendar for a later date.

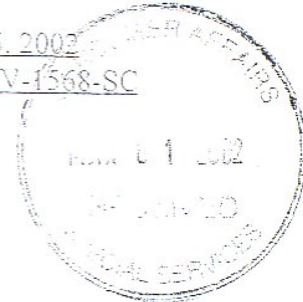

The hearing is an informal procedure used in assisting citizens in resolving certain disputes through the use of mediation. There is no fee for the service and it will provide an opportunity to settle the complaint out of court and thereby avoid a lengthy civil or criminal court procedure. The session is conducted by a trained mediator who is a neutral third party. Witnesses and attorneys may be allowed in the mediation process but are not required. During the hearing, an attending attorney will not be permitted to question the other party and may only speak to their client. These limitations are placed to insure that neither party has an unfair advantage and to encourage both parties to arrive at a joint resolution of the dispute. Witnesses will not ordinarily be admitted to the hearing unless deemed necessary by the mediator. In the hearing, the mediator will listen to both parties and provide an opportunity to reach a mutually acceptable agreement. 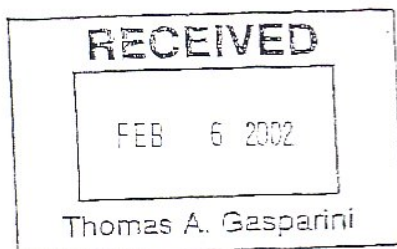
